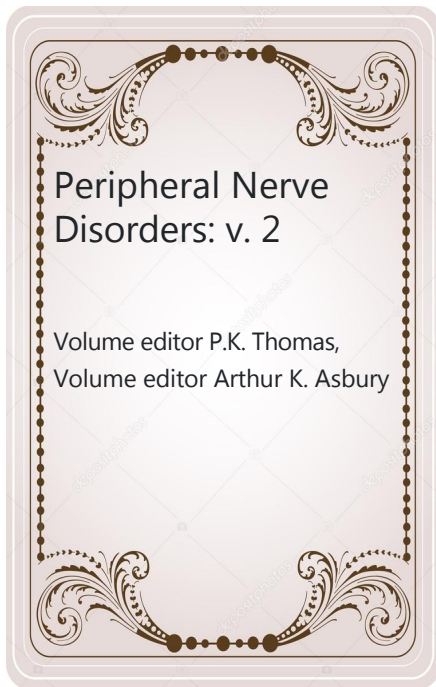


# Peripheral Nerve Disorders: v. 2
